This is an “ultimate” service project that will operate across the rural and remote areas of Victoria and Southern NSW, providing full skin screening. It truly demonstrates the strength of the Lions organisation - but we need your help to make it so!

With 340+ clubs in V Districts a pool of \$100,000 from our clubs towards the \$350,000 needed to establish this project is not beyond the realms of reality.

AWARD LEVELS

We are very grateful to all donors, but we would particularly like to honour donations of \$2000 or more.
